

The Central Penn Business Group on Health was founded as the Lancaster County Business Group on Health by a group of county employers in 1984 and is an affiliate of The Lancaster Chamber. Founding members were concerned about the cost and quality of healthcare and formed the organization to create awareness and solutions. In 2017, the organization expanded its reach to include employers in Adams, Berks, Cumberland, Dauphin, Lebanon and York Counties. The expansion was a direct result of the changing healthcare landscape in Central Pennsylvania.

The membership of the Central Penn Business Group on Health crosses public and private sectors and represents more than several hundred thousand employees and their covered dependents. We represent a wide variety of employers – small and large, union and non-union as well as a wide variety of industries. Our mission is to promote the continuous improvement in the quality and cost of healthcare for our members, their employees and covered dependents.

The Central Penn Business Group on Health is recognized as a resource and advocate for high quality, cost effective healthcare in our region; working to help local businesses cope with the challenges associated with the healthcare benefits they provide to their employees. Although employers do still need guidance to make sure their plans conform to both federal and state regulations, new challenges have arisen that present potential minefields. As employers continue to strive for ways to control their healthcare spend without causing too much disruption to their current plans, a new generation of products and services has been created to help them meet their goals. These new product offerings and delivery system changes do offer opportunities for savings but they also bring with them new challenges for the employers who offer them.

So in addition to an update on the rules and regulations, Eric Athey and Renee Lieux from McNees Wallace and Nurick LLC will walk us through the updates and then lead us through an interactive discussion of emerging best practices, legal landmines and other issues facing employers who seek innovative solutions to their health plan needs.


